MOVING MINISTRY FORWARD

The Zion Long Range Planning Task Force presented suggestions to the congregation at a special meeting held on Sunday, July 20th following worship. Now it is time for small group discussions with questions and suggestions on the five specific areas of the proposal, examining where Zion does well and places where we can improve. Beginning Sunday, September 14, 2025 and for five Sundays, you are invited to join the process as we meet in the Gerhard Lounge to review these ideas in detail. The first topic for discussion will be **OUTREACH** that will be led by Alex Fitzroy on September 14th. Brenda Wolfe will follow on September 21st to focus on **WELCOMING**. The group discussion on **WORSHIP AND MUSIC** will be led by Andrew Sabol on a Sunday to be determined soon. On October 12th, Tom Felmley will discuss how we utilize our facilities and Kathy Gaberson will conclude with the topic of **SPIRITUAL GROWTH** on October 26th. Please bring along your copy of the booklet "The Future of Zion Lutheran Church" that was handed out on July 20th if you have one or additional copies will be available in the Gerhard Lounge.

As Zion begins the call process for a new pastor, this proposal will be a very important document for candidates to review and consider in the interview with the call committee. Pastors will be interested in the direction and level of commitment that Zion will be taking in ministry. Keep in mind that while the call committee is interviewing a candidate, the pastor is also interviewing the congregation to see if they would be a good fit for each other. While the new pastor will come with ideas and suggestions of their own, this will give them important insight into Zion's vision for present and future ministry.

So spend some valuable time on these Sundays to share your thoughts, additional ideas and concerns as we move forward together in ministry to devotedly answer our call in Christ, as we EXPERIENCE GOD, GROW IN FAITH, AND SERVE OTHERS.




